

Minor Problem Behavior	Definition
Disrespect/Defiance/ Non-Compliance	Refusal to follow directions, talking back, or being disrespectful to adults.
Disruption	Behavior that causes a disruption that interferes with the educational process, including yelling, screaming, play fighting, and or sustained out of seat behavior.
Inappropriate Language	Profanity (Verbal and/or written messages) including swearing, name calling, insulting remarks/rumors, or use of words in an inappropriate way.
Physical Contact/ Physical Aggression	Student engages in non-serious, but inappropriate physical contact.
Property Misuse	Student deliberately impairs the usefulness of property.

Major Problem Behavior	Definition
Vandalism/Arson	Intentionally causing or attempting to cause damage to property, of other people, or of the school.
Bullying	The repetitive delivery of a direct message that involve intimidation, teasing, taunting, threats, or name calling.
Repeated Minor Offenses	A repeat of any of the minor offenses over a period of time. (Excess of four weeks)
Physical Aggression Fighting	Action that involves force on another person where injury can occur. (Hitting, pushing, kicking, biting, hair pulling, scratching, or hitting with an object).
Inappropriate Display of Affection	Actions that involve touching, displaying, and sharing private areas of self or others. (Body parts that are covered by undergarments)
Other	(Out of bounds/weaponry/theft)
