Procedure:
<p>Teach expectations through the “tell, model, practice” sequence.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Walk students to the hallway and tell students the expectations for the hallway using the matrix above.2. Model the expectations for the hallway using the matrix above.3. Practice the expectations with the students.

Closure:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Show students the hallway expectations poster and review what they are to do in the hallway.• Provide specific and public positive feedback to students who display critical skills. Be sure to let students know what rule he/she followed and the specific behavior he/she displayed.
