

# Bus Expectations

<b>Be Safe</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stay in your seat</li><li>• Get out of your seat only when it's time to exit</li><li>• Keep hands and feet to your self</li></ul>	<b>Be Respectful</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Talk with indoor voice</li><li>• Follow all directions and safety rules</li></ul>	<b>Be Cooperative</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be helpful, share your seat</li></ul>	<b>Be Responsible</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep yourself and your belongings in your space</li></ul>
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<b>Objective:</b>  TLW demonstrate knowledge of bus expectations by displaying appropriate bus behavior.	<b>Materials:</b>  Poster of bus expectations
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<b>Procedure:</b> <b>Teach</b> expectations through the “ <b>tell, model, practice</b> ” sequence.  1. Walk students to the bus and <b>tell</b> students the expectations for the bus using matrix above.  2. <b>Model</b> the expectations for the bus using the matrix above.  3. Practice the expectations with the students.
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<b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Review bus expectations using the bus poster.</li><li>• <b>Provide specific and public positive feedback</b> to students who display critical skills. Be sure to let students know what rule he/she followed and the specific behavior he/she displayed.</li></ul>
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
